Limitless tv series parents guide

Netflix's ambitious, expensive new show is highly spectacted and of profound quality. But in terms of content, The Crown is not a jewel. [3] [4] The film starred Jake McDorman as Brian Finch, who discovers the power of a mysterious nootropic drug under the name NZT-48. This drug unlocks the full potential of the human brain and provides users with enhanced mental abilities. It is a spin-off for the film of the same name, so is based on the 2001 novel The Dark Fields, and takes place four years after the events of the film. The film was ordered by CBS on May 8, 2015. On October 23, 2015, CBS selected Limitless for a full 22-episode season. [5] On May 18, 2016, CBS confirmed Limitless would not be joining the network's 2016-2017 lineup, and on May 25, 2016, CBS executive Craig Sweeny announced the film had been canceled after one season. [6] The 28-year-old Brian Finch (McDorman), an exhausted and struggling musician, was introduced to NZT-48, a miracle drug that gives him access to every neuron in his brain. In the twelve hours after taking the pills, he became the smartest person in the world, able to completely recall every detail of his life and capable of extraordinary leaps of intuition and reasoning. Production development On October 31, 2014, it was announced that actor Bradley Cooper had decided to develop a drama based on a film, and had teamed up with Alex Kurtzman and Roberto Orci to develop the concept. CBS Television Studios has been shopping for shows for U.S. broadcast networks. Craig Sweeny will write the series, while Cooper will be executive producer. [37] CBS ordered a pilot on January 28, 2015. In addition to Cooper, Kurtzman, Orci, and Sweeny will serve as executive producers for the film, which is set four years after the original film. Limitless received mixed reviews from critics. Review a general website Rotten reported a 57% approval rating with an average rating of 6.39/10 based on 47 reviews. The consensus of critics of the site read, Even with a likable likable infinitely unable to overcome its credible stress and shaky, hole-riddled story.
